The North Hastings Non-Profit Housing Corporation (NHNPHC) is currently inviting applications to create a new volunteer Board of Directors. The Board will consist of no fewer than four and no more than eight Directors including the Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and Treasurer.

The NHNPHC is the only Non-Profit Housing Provider in Bancroft serving families in need of rent-geared-to-income housing. The 57-unit property, known as Woodview Lane Townhomes has a mix of 1, 2, 3, and 4-bedroom townhouses and provides low-income housing for a mix of singles, families and seniors.

Rights and Responsibilities of the Board of Directors:

- overall direction to the NHNPHC including development, review and approval of governance policies;
- receipt of updates on the Corporation's activities, financial statements and the auditors' report
- ensure financial stability;
- assess the Corporation's performance;
- meet regularly at a time and place that the Board decides and host/attend one annual general meeting; and
- be the public face of the corporation.

- Compassion and respect for others
- Willingness to learn
- A sense of wider community and passion for the mission of the organization
